- Business contracts as proof of operation
- Testimonials from Spouse/Pastor/Minister (responsible person)
- Photos of safekeeping facility and security of property
- Training certificates and all other firearm related certificates/achievements (responsible person)
- Competency card front and back
- Copy of existing firearm licences (including a list of any firearms that are still pending outcome if applied for)

- 2. If your firearm has expired, you don't need to hand it in at any police station.

If you haven't received any response, check that the spelling of my e-mail address is correct or contact me if you haven't received any response by the end of the day when the e-mail address has been entered correctly. (E-mails sent on a weekend, will be responded to on a Monday morning at the latest)
